## Congregational Meeting

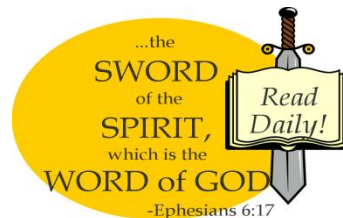
November 26<sup>th</sup> after Worship Service
